We have a brand new coaching team of Harri, Lauren and Bea, and together with a hefty number of returners from last year, this promises to be a great year for the club.





Our taster day this year saw around 60 NEW ROWERS try out the sport for the first time! We put out 12 boats of novices across the day, followed by a barbecue at the boathouse and a sigh of relief from our captains! Of these people, almost none have had any experience rowing before – a unique appearance amongst Oxford colleges. A solid number of these carried on rowing throughout the term, though due to weather conditions beyond our control, the novice regatta usually run in November was unfortunately cancelled. The women dug deep with a bi-weekly 30 min rate 20 erg plus sessions in the tank at Iffley sports centre for everyone. Many ergs, tanks, circuits and core workouts later, the colours of red and yellow were once again seen on the river, when 8<sup>th</sup> week river conditions allowed us to return, stronger, fitter and faster than ever.
